

Descendants of Levi Pierce

1. Levi² Pierce (Reuben¹) was born 1810 in SC, and died 1886 in Pine Log, Bartow Co., GA. He married Matilda H. Upshaw December 08, 1836 in Cass Co., GA, daughter of James Upshaw and Lucinda Ham. Notes for Levi Pierce: Levi Pierce was in school in Capt. Dorsey's 575th Militia District, Hall County, 5 Jul 1825 with Greenberry Russell, Reyben H. Pierce and Hamton Pierce. Martha Pierce was listed as parent or guardian of the three Pierce children. He was listed in the same district 1 Apr 1828 with Reuben H. Pierce, Elizabeth Russell and William G. Russell.<54>

On 3 Mar 1831 (p. 14), 3 Jun 1831 (p. 156), 26 Jul, 1832 (p. 338), and 3 Aug 1832 (p. 343, twice), Levi (Levy, Livy) Pierce was listed in account books of Frances C. Anoc's stores or taverns in Hall Co. or Cherokee Indian Nation.<55>

Cass County was created from Cherokee Indian Lands in 1832. Levi was probably attracted there by free or cheap land. He married Matilda Upshaw in that county 8 Dec 1836, the same month and year that Reuben H. Pierce married Sarah Baker in Hall County. Descendants speculated that

Levi came from Elbert County, GA, or western SC with James Upshaw, Matilda's father, and Martin Maxwell, his brother-in-law around 1834-1836. Levi and Matilda settled in Pine Log, Cass County.<56>

In 1840, Levi(age 30-40) and Matilda H. Pierce(age 20-30), were in the 827th District, Cass Co., GA, with a daughter under 5. Nearby in the same district and county was Reuben H.(age 20-30) and Sarah Pierce(age 20-30), with two sons under the age of five.<31>

On 3 March, 1847, Matilda's father, James Upshaw's will was probated. His Children were: John J., Emily C, Mildred A., Julia Ann Maxwell, Jannette S., Matilda H. Pierce, Polly M., Clara G., Thomas S., Sarah E., Martha G. and Lucinda C. His widow, Lucinda, was executrix. Witnesses were: T. Aycock, Lindsay Johnson, Edw. Barrett and Lindsay Oglesby.<57>

On 28 Sep 1847, Book U, p. 548, the heirs to the estate of James Upshaw gave right of title of land, being lot 216, District 22, Section 2 to Levi Pierce. Heirs were: Lucinda Upshaw, widow; Mary Upshaw; John P.

Upshaw; Thomas Upshaw; Martin Maxwell; A. Vincent; Joseph Dysert; William Irwin; and Patrick Neddleton.<58>

In 1850, Levi Pierce operated a millwright and cabinet shop at a point between the Cassville and Adairsville roads. Thirty years later, at the age of 70, he was still operating the same shop.<56> In the 1880 Georgia Census, Levi gave place of birth of both his parents as North Carolina, which differs from Reuben H. Pierce's account of his parents.<59> Levi died in 1886 and was buried in the Pine Log Methodist Cemetery. Matilda was buried next to him in 1890.<60>
